

Commodore 128 Screen Editor Escape Codes

Compiled & corrected from the Commodore 128 System Guide

Works in both 40 and 80 column modes:

ESC A / ESC C	Enable/Disable Auto-Insert Mode
ESC T / ESC B	Define Top left / Bottom right corners of window
ESC D / ESC I	Delete / Insert rows (on screen, doesn't affect program)
ESC E / ESC F	Disable / Enable cursor flashing
ESC G / ESC H / CTRL G	Enable / Disable / Ring bell
ESC J / ESC K	Jump to Beginning / End of logical line
ESC L / ESC M	Screen scrolling / screen wrap modes
ESC O	Cancel Quote, Insert, Reverse modes - but not Auto-Insert mode
ESC P / ESC Q / ESC @	Erase to start of line / end of line / end of screen
ESC V / ESC W	Scroll screen upwards / downwards
ESC Y / ESC Z / CTRL X	Set default tabs / clear all tabs / set tab at cursor
CTRL K / CTRL L	Shift+C= character set switching disable / enable
ESC X	Toggle between 40 and 80 column display

80 column specific:

ESC U / ESC S	Underline / block cursor
ESC R / ESC N	Reverse / Normal video mode

Notes:

1. I didn't demonstrate the 80 column features as I don't have a video capture solution for that mode currently!
2. The C128 System Guide incorrectly has the functions of ESC C and ESC O swapped
3. CTRL [is equivalent to pressing ESC, CTRL I is equivalent to Tab
